

SAFA SCHOOLS FOOTBALL PROGRAMME - REGISTRATION

Dear Colleagues

The Association is delighted to announce that the schools registration system is now active on the homepage of the SAFA website. We therefore request that all schools that intend to play Football in 2016 register through the online registration system. Registered Schools will be eligible to participate from district level to the national tournament depending on the classification of that particular league format.

The process of registration is as follows:

- Manually let each player complete a registration form which should be returned to the coach with a copy of ID or birth certificate, colour ID photo and a parent's signature on the registration form;
- 2. The coach or administrator should then register on the online system as the administrator for that school. Once registered as a coach/administrator you can then register all your players online;
- 3. The completed forms should be taken to your LFA Schools Football Coordinator who is tasked with verifying the documents of the players;
- After the verification of the players by the LFA Schools Football Coordinator, players will either be "approved" or "pending", due to outstanding documents or information;
- 5. The whole process should take 48-72 hours to complete from the time the forms are submitted to the LFA Schools coordinator;
- 6. Roadshows for the registration process will be done in the next few weeks.

Should any school require assistance with entering player information in the online system due to lack of technology assets or expertise, the forms can be posted or delivered at the LFA offices in your area.

NB: All the sponsored competitions of a specific age group will now be interlinked with the leagues played from district level. Further details will be provided in the next circular.

The fixtures for the Wednesday Schools Football days will be circulated by the LFA Schools Coordinator. As the Association, we see this as the next best step into ensuring that we deliver on our mandate of delivering on Schools Football in the country.

The Association would like to confirm that on Thursday 10 March 2016, the Association will be meeting with SADTU regarding the letter that they circulated to all schools regarding schools Football.
